Booster Club Meeting

Members present: Carrie Mentele, Lisa Genzlinger, Kay Kramer, Stacy Kampshoff, Eric Feldhaus, Pat Ruml and Ange Rentz

Secretary's report was read and 2 clarifications were made and 1 correction noted \$700 FFA for state convention. Removed statement from 04/11/2018 about Pat talked to Mr. Lee regarding B????
Minutes were approved as clarified and corrected, 1st by Carrie and 2nd by Lisa.

Treasurer's report read – Payouts to FFA, FCCLA, Acceleration training. \$954 in income from JH Track meet. Balance after monthly payouts is around \$30,841 with \$2300 left to distribute for requests (\$600 – Golf, \$500 – Football landscaping, \$600 - GBB, leaving the balance around \$26,000. Concession stand income for the year was around \$8000.

HS Track meet showed profits of \$397.50.

Concession stands will still need to be cleaned and the extra stuff will be distributed to the Canova Concession stand. Treasurer's report was approved a 1st by Angie and 2nd by Kay.

Booster Club will get approval from the Building and Grounds committee (school board) for the wall wrap that Booster Club would like to pay for and install. Kay received an email from Taylor Kiehl, who is working for Fox Print. She will be helping us design the wall wrap. Erin said that she would take over this project. Wall wrap cannot go to the ceiling on east side of stage due to school needing a white wall to show movies etc. We will wait to install wall wrap until addition is complete, due to mess and dust being a problem. Booster club decided that no people will be used in photo. Fox Print has the Howard Tiger official logo.

New Business:

Kay showed the group a design for the set up of the concession stand. Suggested that we ensure there are cupboards that are large enough to store coffee pots and roaster. Maybe cupboards with no doors. 2 windows are in the plan now – may suggest to Mr. Lee to have 1 10' window instead. Make sure that there are a lot of plugs in inside the concession stand. Kay will send an email to Mr. Lee, Evan Meyer and Julie Schwader with the ideas from Booster Club.

Athletic Banquet was held and approximately 175 people were fed. Bill to come from Animals for meal. \$497 in tickets were sold for the meal.

Appliances in concession stand – Freezer, Frig, microwave and popcorn popper will cost around \$2300. Karl's had the best prices. Kay will be disposing of old stuff under grandstand at football to be tossed during the city wide clean up.

Requests for booster club funding:

\$500 – VB for huddle assist (breakdown film and figure stats) – approved 1st by Kay and 2nd by Carrie

\$500 - BBB for 3 camps, JV and V, will serve approximately 16 kids - approved 1st by Angie and 2nd by Carrie

\$1000 – Wrestling for IA camp. 10 kids at \$265 each. Approved – 1st by Kay and 2nd by Angie

Kay purchased 3 metal popcorn scoops for the armory, HS and track concession stands.

The booster club will be doing online clothing sales again this year.

Funding for Basketball hoops at elementary school will be tabled until next month until we hear from Adam Shumaker on grants received. 5 poles will be put up at school for hoops. Angie texted Adam to get an update on status.

The booster club will look at Athletic Club posters with the schedule on it. The group will look at how to proceed.

Angie Neises will be in charge of the football club – she is the contact person

Angie Rentz and Dawn Hamilton will complete the list of workers for the 2018-2019 concession stand.

Bill paid were: Girls BB, Acceleration, Kay Kramer (scoops), Coke (Chesterman) and Rusty's.
