Booster Club Zoom meeting –

Erin called the meeting to order.

Jean Morrison will bill the booster club for the sports listings for 2020-2021 school year band calendar. This will include all the JH and High School activities. Motion made to approve by Lisa and 2nd by Stacy

A request from volleyball to pay for the Huddle Assist for the 2020 season in the amount of \$800. Motion was made by Angie to approve and a 2nd by Erin.

Girls and Boys Basketball requested \$2500 from Booster club for the purchase of Dr Dish Shooting Machine. Motion was made to approve by Lisa and a 2nd by Angie

NHS requested \$203.55 for the cords and pins to be paid by Booster Club – Lisa made a motion to approve and a 2nd by Stacy.

After Prom did not need the funds previously requested.

Jean Morrison requested funds (\$75) to purchase shirts for the Jazz Band in March. 21 students. Motion was made by Erin to pay this and a 2nd by Lisa.

FCCLA request for funds to help with State FCCLA – this did not happen, therefore request will not be paid.

FFA state was also held virtually and this request will not be paid.

Baseball had a request for funds and club baseball did not happen due to Covid 19, therefore this request will not be paid.

Booster Club will pay Fox Print for the Senior Yard Signs in the amount of \$293.75. Motion was made by Erin and a 2nd by Stacy.

Pat Ruml requested funds from booster club to expand the crows nest at the football field. A motion was made by Stacy to give \$5000 to the expansion and a 2nd by Angie

Erin is talking with Fox Print about doing the Senior posters and the schedule posters – this will be finalized in the near future.

Booster Club will look at what needs to be purchased or replaced for 2020 -2021 school year. We will look at labeling the cupboards and drawers in the concession stand.

\$4547.41 has been requested from groups out of the \$8000 allocated for the 2019-2021 school year. The \$5,000 will not come out of the \$8000 allocated – it will be the Booster Clubs large group project.
