Booster Club Meeting

Persons in attendance: Erin Feldhaus, Lisa Genzlinger, Carrie Mentele, Angie Rentz, Pat Ruml and Travis Aslesen.

Secretary's report was read and approved as read – 1st by Lisa and 2nd by Erin.

Treasurer's report - \$4600 was used in 2019-2020 school year of the \$8000 allocated. There is a \$18,800 balance in account.

Lisa made a motion to allocate \$8000 for the 2020-2021 school to be given to groups as approved and requested. Carrie 2nd.

Fox print will do the Senior posters. Posters with the schedule on them will also be done by Fox Print. We will distribute to the businesses without a fee for the Fall Sports. Last year the sports posters cost 8.50 and the Senior Posters cost 17.75.

Tiger masks are being sold by the booster club. They are selling well. It is being advertised through the Booster Club facebook page, Howard High School Facebook page, will be sent out in a mass mailing through the school and a newspaper ad.

Travis Aslesen went over the guidelines suggested by the state for concession stands. We will look at having everything in packages, such as pizza, BBQ, chips, meat, cheese and pretzels. Mr. A stated that workers will need to be screened and their temperature taken prior to working. It was suggested that we look at have people who only handle the money and a separate person for each area. (popcorn, pop, pizza and pretzels) Fox Print will be ordering spots for the floor to suggest where people should stand while in line for the concession stand. Erin wondered about getting packs of jerky in the stand for resale.

The group talked about other options for viewing the school events while at home. The system we currently have it not working out. Erin will contact someone (Brozik) about a system that was used during baseball and Mr. A. has been in contact Alliance. The group would look at paying someone to do the commentating at the events as needed. The school has a contract with NFHS until 05/2021.

The crow's nest at the football field is coming along. They are waiting for the windows to come in.
